## Student Visa

### ❖ Checklist:- Is my application Complete?

<b>Note</b>	
Student Visas are issued to bona-fide students to pursue studies in recognised educational institutions in India for the duration of the academic course of study or for a period of five years, whichever is less, on the basis of firm letters confirming admission of the applicant and duration of the course.	
<b>Documents you need for a complete Student Visa Application</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Application <b>Form ‘A’</b> fully completed and signed.</li> <li>➤ If you are currently a holder of a Pakistani passport or a dual citizen of Pakistan, you need to fill in <b>Form B</b>. If holding dual citizenship, both passports need to be submitted. Visa will be issued on your Pakistani passport. If you do not hold dual nationality of Pakistan, you are required to submit statutory Declaration duly attested by the competent authorities (Notary Public or Justice of Peace) stating that you do not hold Pakistani nationality. If you are only visiting one city in India, you must submit your application in quadruplet (four sets). If visiting two cities in India, you must submit in quintuplet (five sets). If visiting three cities in India, you must submit in sextuplicate (six sets).</li> <li>➤ If you are currently a holder of a Bangladeshi passport or a dual citizen of Bangladesh, you need to fill in <b>Form C</b>. If holding dual citizenship, both passports need to be submitted. Visa will be issued on your Bangladeshi passport. If the Bangladeshi passport cannot be produced, the applicant has to submit a Statutory Declaration duly attested by the competent authorities (Notary Public or Justice of Peace) stating that you do not hold a Bangladeshi passport.</li> <li>➤ If you are currently holding a Sri Lankan with dual nationality, the visa would be issued on your Sri Lankan passport only. If the Sri Lankan passport cannot be produced, you are required to submit a Statutory Declaration duly attested by the competent authorities (Notary Public or Justice of Peace) stating that you do not hold a Sri Lankan passport.</li> <li>➤ If you are currently holding a New Zealand Passport and you are permanent resident of Australia then submit photocopy of Medicare card.             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ I have indicated the places of visit and duration of stay clearly on the form.</li> <li>○ I have provided accurate contact details (telephone/mobile numbers) that can be used to reach me in both Australia and India.</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ One recent photograph meeting specifications listed in “What size photo do I need?” under <u>“Prepare application”</u></li> <li>➤ Current original passport/travel document with a minimum validity of six months and must have at least two blank pages.</li> <li>➤ Letter from University/ Recognized educational institution – confirming</li> </ul>

➤ Form H if you are applying to visit any <b><u>restricted</u></b> and/ or <b><u>protected</u></b> areas in India	
➤ Form D to be filled by all non-Australian passport holders who do not have Permanent Resident (PR) status in Australia, except as specified below.  ➤ Photocopy of Medicare Card to be provided by all non-Australian passport holders who have Permanent Resident (PR) status, except as specified below. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Form D should be submitted by all applicants belonging to the following categories even if they have Permanent Resident (PR) status in Australia. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Category A: All applicants currently holding passports of Afghanistan, Bangladesh, China, DPR Korea (North Korea), Iran, Sri Lanka and Pakistan.</li> <li>▪ Category B: All applicants with dual citizenship of Afghanistan, Bangladesh, China, DPR Korea (North Korea), Iran, Sri Lanka and Pakistan. Applicants in this category must submit both passports with their applications. (Visas for Pakistani and Bangladeshi applicants will be issued on their Pakistani and Bangladeshi passports only).</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Category C: All applicants who were previously passport holders of Afghanistan, Bangladesh, China, DPR Korea (North Korea), Iran, Sri Lanka and Pakistan.</li><li>▪ Form D must be submitted by all Australian passport holders who are currently having dual citizenship of, or were previously passport holders of Afghanistan, Bangladesh, China, DPR Korea (North Korea), Iran, Sri Lanka and Pakistan.</li></ul>	
<p>➤ <b>For minor (less than 15 years old):</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Copy of birth certificate and Copy of parents passport</li><li>○ No objection letter (letter of consent) from <b>both</b> the parents or</li><li>○ Signature of parents (<b>both</b>) on the visa application form</li><li>○ In case of single parent/guardian: custody papers from the court</li></ul>	

**How do I collect my passport once my visa is processed?**

- Once the status for your application is shown on the website [www.vfs-in-au.net](http://www.vfs-in-au.net) as processed and ready for collection, you may come in person to pick up your documents between 10:30am and 3:00pm, Monday to Friday on all working days.
- If you choose to send someone on your behalf then you must give him/her an [authorization letter](#).
- If you have opted for return of your documents by post / courier while applying, they will be posted / couriered to you the day we receive your passport to the address previously specified by you.
